WY-TOPP Summative Writing Test for 7th Grade

Every spring as part of our district and state assessment system, students are required to take WY-TOPP tests in Math, ELA, and Science. In 7th grade, students are required to take a writing assessment as a piece of the ELA test. This year will have a slight change with the 7th grade writing test. This portion of the assessment will be completed in March while the remaining assessments will be completed in April and May. The writing assessment has a two week testing window but with our scheduled Spring Break, that window is limited to four school days starting on March 4 through March 7.

What does that mean for 7th grade students? **All 7th grade students will take the writing assessment starting on Monday, March 4th.** A testing schedule has been created that will allow all 7th grade students to take the assessment in the morning during 1st through 3rd hour. It's super important that all 7th grade students are at school on Monday March 4th, so we can complete this requirement of our district and state assessment system. Any student who's absent on Monday will be tested when they return on Tuesday.
