Big News - Grade Weighting for Advanced Courses

In 2017 the Wyoming Legislature instituted a grade weighting policy that accounts for the increased academic rigor of high school courses. Included courses:

- AP
- IB
- **+1000 level dual/concurrent courses**

Big News - Grade Weighting for College Courses

Grade	4.0 Point Value	5.0 Point Value
A	4.0	5.0
B	3.0	4.0
C	2.0	3.0

- Where this become important is that, “Districts may continue to maintain their local policies for grade-weighting for other purposes.”
- This grade weighting will **not** be used to determine class rank at MVHS. It is strictly for Hathaway calculations. *handout
