Dear Parents and Students:

As a part of our remote learning plan for grades 6 - 12, at the end of the semester parents will have an opportunity to select that their student receive either the letter grade that they earned in their classes or select an "S" grade for Satisfactory. This process will begin next week, probably on Thursday. Additional information will be sent out at that time.

The S grade will not help or hurt your student's grade point average. It will indicate that your student received credit for that class, but the grade points associated with that credit will not count toward your student's cumulative GPA. A parent will select whether they want their child to accept the letter grade for each class (where the grade points will impact a student's cumulative GPA) or select an S grade for that class.

This grade confirmation process has to occur from the PowerSchool parent portal, NOT from a student's PowerSchool login. Many parents are used to checking their student's grades via the student portal. **We ask that before next week parents click on the PowerSchool parent portal link below and confirm they can log in.**

1. Login to the PowerSchool parent portal at <https://ps.uinta4.com/public/home.html>
2. A handy place to remember to find the link is on our district web page: Uinta4.com and look under the "For Parents" tab and click on PowerSchool.

There is a change password link on that PowerSchool page. If you click on change password and don't receive an email back, you may be using the wrong email address (or at least an email we don't have on file) or the change password link is being directed to your Spam folder.

This grade change process is to be completed by a parent and will require an electronic signature. Once a parent confirms grades, a parent cannot log in and change grades a second time. **Next week specific directions for the grade change process along with a deadline to make the change will be sent out.**
