ACT for Seniors in October

We want all students to have a college-reportable score on the ACT before they graduate. For that reason, we are scheduling an ACT on October 6, 2020 for all seniors in the class of 2021.

Even seniors who have already taken the ACT will be required to take the test as this is an opportunity to both take the test again and to take it on your home floor at least once before graduation.

We know the school closure was a disruption to all of our students and we also want to prioritize those things that help students have a successful start to college, including the Hathaway Scholarship.

We are also planning on next year's juniors taking the ACT in April as normal. Remember that all 9-11 grade students are eligible for an ACT reimbursement. See Miss Lupher for details on reimbursement!

August 2020 Registration Information

- We are developing a plan for students to come in and register in August prior to the start of school in order to pick up schedules and be assigned a hallway locker. Additional information will be emailed out to parents and students in August once we have a better idea of limitations placed on crowd sizes and social distancing at that time. Be sure you check your email in July and August for updates related to registration and the start of school.
- Due to legislative rules regarding fractional enrollment and school accounting of students, **MVHS students are only allowed one release period, this includes seniors.** Understand that we will require all students to have a full schedule unless they qualify for the single release time.
- *Incoming senior students who were not proficient on the ACT in Math must take a fourth year of math their senior year. Students must have a 20 on the Math subtest of the ACT in order to opt out of math as a senior.*

- The end of semester grade confirmations that parents completed last week will be reflected on final student report cards. These changes will not show up on student or parent Quick Lookup screens on PowerSchool right now. **“S” or Satisfactory grades will show on final report cards and transcripts.**
- All parents will soon receive a notification that report cards are available on the PowerSchool Parent Portal. Please login to the Parent Portal and print off your students’ report cards as they will only be available until **June 15. Parents will not be able to access report cards after June 15.**
- You may have noticed some of our sports teams getting together for limited practices and camps recently. These practices are the result of county variances submitted to the Uinta County Health Department. Athletes and coaches must currently complete a health screen before every practice before they participate in practices or camps. **Thanks to Mr. Rees for taking the lead and doing such a good job with writing these variances in support of our athletes.**
- **Yearbooks will be available in the fall.** The COVID pandemic slowed down shipping of the yearbooks at the end of the school year.
