

Uinta 4 will be using Health Ed Check, a web application that allows students, staff, and visitors to quickly and easily submit a wellness self-assessment to determine if they should enter school facilities. Health Ed Check is designed to run on mobile devices and works seamlessly with PowerSchool, allowing district and school administrators to monitor the wellness of every person entering school buildings.

Uinta 4 is requesting the Health Ed Check be completed at home each morning prior to sending your student to school.

There are multiple ways the Health Ed Check can be completed.

1. Parents/guardians can login through their Parent Portal <https://ps.uinta4.com/public> and click on the icon named HealthEd Check (it's a little green shield with a white + in it). This will allow the parent/guardian to directly login for that student rather than having to know a different username and password for that student. Parents/guardians would still need to complete this for each separate student in their family. This is the easiest way for parents/guardians to complete the Health Check for their students. However, you MUST be able to login to your Parent Portal with your username and password on a DAILY basis. Please make sure you are able to do that before school starts. If you don't know what your password is, there are directions for resetting it on the sign in page of the portal.

2. Parents/guardians, and older students, could also complete the HealthEd Check using their smartphone. In order to do that, the attached flyer displays the Username, Password, website, and QR code needed for your student(s).

On your smartphone, open the following website in Safari <https://uinta4-covid.phoenixlearning.com> then tap the "Action Button" (little square with an arrow pointing upward). Then tap "Add to Home Screen Button". (You may need to move down or right to locate this option.) You may rename the Button (which is optional), and then tap Add. This will create a Button/Icon on your smartphone. Confirm the new Button/Icon appears on the Home Screen.

Parents/guardians, and students will need to use their student's Username, and Password from the attached flyer to complete this process using a smartphone.

For an older student, using their smartphone, they may wish to save their Username & Password. For a parent with multiple students, this would not be a good idea. Taking a picture of the username and password would also be a good option, so it could be referred back to as needed.

3. If you wish to use the QR Code Scan shown on the attached flyer to set the app up on your smartphone, your smartphone must be set up to read QR codes. There are YouTube videos showing how to accomplish that.
