## 1-WELCOME BACK!

We are super excited to get students back into the building for the upcoming school year. With fall sports starting on August 16, it is certainly an exciting time of year and we are hoping to see the class of 2022 have one of the best years EVER! Hopefully you've had a chance to do all the things this summer that you planned on doing in the spring.

Be sure you have registration on your "To Do" list. 11th and 12th grade registration is Monday, August 23; 9th and 10th registration is Tuesday, August 24 (with a **new student orientation that evening at 6:00**); and the new student and make up registration scheduled for Wednesday, August 25. Students will pay a registration fee, Chromebook deposit, and any fees for specific classes.

## 2-CHROMEBOOKS FOR ALL! ( AGAIN )

We will continue our system from last year where each student will be issued a Chromebook. We ask that you keep that computer with you during school so you always have access to it and it is charged and ready to go. Our school network does not allow students to "bring their own device." We expect you to **use your assigned computer** when you are at school.

Students will be issued their Chromebook when they register for school and pay their Chromebook deposit. 9th and 10th graders will have a \$50 Chromebook deposit and 11th and 12th graders will have a \$30 Chromebook deposit. (The 11th and 12th graders already paid a \$20 textbook deposit when they registered for school as 9th graders.)

Last year went really well in terms of managing the Chromebooks. Important Reminder: you are responsible for any damages or repairs to your Chromebook. It needs to be a priority to take care of them and use the issued neoprene sleeve to help keep that Chromebook shiny and new.

## 3-SELECTIVE SERVICE REGISTRATION

Under current law, all male US citizens between 18–25 years of age, born after January 1, 1960 are required to register for the Selective Service within 30 days of their 18th birthday.

A young man who fails to register with Selective Service may be ineligible for opportunities important to his future. He must register to be eligible for the selective service for federal student financial aid, some state-funded student financial aid, most federal employment, some state employment, security clearance for contractors, and job training under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act.
