Guidelines and Application

1. The Mountain View High School Visual Art Scholarship will be awarded to one graduating senior with a one-time payment of \$1,000.00.
2. Qualified applicants must be a MVHS Senior and have been accepted to a bona fide post high school graduate college, university, or technical school as a full-time student.
3. Applicants who have declared a major or minor in the Visual Arts will be given preference in the selection process.
4. Applicants must be an active member of the MVHS Art Club and be currently enrolled in at least one art class.
5. Applicants must hold a minimum high school GPA of 2.75.
6. Applicants will submit a completed application and a portfolio of 10 to 15 pieces of original artwork on a CD or USB thumb drive labeled with the applicant's name. They will also complete the Image List with title, size, date, media, and reference used (own photo, combined photos, observation, imagination).
 - a. Images should not exceed the size of 800 pixels for the width or height at the resolution of 72 dpi.
 - b. The file type of the images must be in JPEG format (.jpg) in RGB color mode at the highest quality.
 - c. Name each image with a file name using your last name and a number beginning with two zeros (i.e., smith001.jpg, smith002.jpg) with no spaces between them.
7. An envelope labeled MVHS Visual Art Scholarship that contains three copies of the application, three copies of the image list, and the image CD will be submitted to the counselor's office by the first Monday in April. Late applications will not be accepted.
8. Upon graduation, the awardee will be given an official information sheet to be taken to their college to verify enrollment. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE AWARDEE to return that information sheet to the Business Manager at Uinta County School District #4. At that time, a check for the entire award will be sent to the school stated.

Mountain View High School Visual Art Scholarship

OVERVIEW

1. The Mountain View High School Visual Art Scholarship will be awarded to one graduating senior with a one-time payment of \$1,000.00.
2. The scholarship will continue to be awarded annually as long as the scholarship account has sufficient funds. It is urged that the current MVHS art club advisor continue to deposit \$1,000.00 yearly to keep the scholarship going into the future.
3. Qualified applicants must have applied and been accepted to a bona fide post-high school graduate college, university, or technical school as a full-time student.
4. Applicants who have declared a major or minor in the Visual Arts will be given preference in the selection process.
5. Applicants must be enrolled in at least one MVHS art class and be an active member of the MVHS art club.
6. Applicants must hold a minimum high school GPA of 2.75.
7. Applicants will submit a completed application and a portfolio of 10 to 15 pieces of original artwork on a CD or USB thumb drive labeled with the applicant's name. They will also complete the Image List with title, size, date, media, and reference used (own photo, combined photos, observation, imagination).
 - a. Images should not exceed the size of 800 pixels for the width or height at the resolution of 72 dpi.
 - b. The file type of the images must be in JPEG format (.jpg) in RGB color mode at the highest quality.
 - c. Name each image with a file name using your last name and a number beginning with two zeros (i.e., smith001.jpg, smith002.jpg) with no spaces between them.
8. An envelope labeled MVHS Visual Art Scholarship that contains three copies of the application, three copies of the image list, three copies of the essay and the image CD will be returned to the counselor's office by the first Monday in April. Late applications will not be accepted.
9. Upon graduation, the awardee will be given an official information sheet to be taken to their college to verify enrollment. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE AWARDEE to return that information sheet to the Business Manager at Uinta County School District #4. At that time, a check for the entire award will be sent to the school stated.
10. The scholarship will be judged by Mrs. Tara Taylor (or a person designated by her) and two other qualified people selected by her. The winning applicant's name will then be given to the MVHS counselor and district office manager by the 1st Monday in May.
11. Any interest accrued by the award will remain in the scholarship fund.
