Overview

Administration

This scholarship will be under the direct supervision of the Uinta County Farm Bureau Board of Directors. A committee composed of the Uinta County Farm Bureau executive board, one or two appointees of the board of directors, and, if deemed necessary, the scholarship representative from the county schools will be making the final decision.

Scholarship

The Uinta County Farm Bureau Board of Directors has determined that \$250.00 shall come from the county board, \$125 from the Farm Bureau office in Evanston, and \$125.00 from the Farm Bureau office in Bridger Valley, thus providing a single scholarship in the amount of \$500.00.

Scholarship funds will be disbursed upon presentation of proof of enrollment in an approved school. One-half (\$250.00) will be disbursed for the first semester enrolled, and the second half of the scholarship (\$250.00) for the second semester enrolled. The applicant must maintain a 3.0 grade point average in the first semester and show proof of enrollment for the second semester, in order to receive the second half of the scholarship.

Qualifications

Scholarship may be used at a university, 2-year college, or at a trade school, preferably in the state of Wyoming. The type of education desired will constitute the choice of school, whether in Wyoming or out of state; however, strong consideration will be given to those applicants who are planning to attend a Wyoming school.

High school seniors may apply. Applicants should be planning on continuing their education in the agriculture field, which could include, for example, animal science, range management, agriculture loan officer, business management, extension service officer, home economics, weed and pest control, etc.

Applicants must have maintained a 3.0 grade point average for the past 3 years in high school. Enrollment must be within one year after high school graduation. Failure to meet these criteria will negate award, and scholarship will be awarded to an alternate.

2. Letters of recommendation from: at least 2 teachers who have taught you in the last two years, a school administrator, and recent employer if applicable.
