  - Application Deadline is March 18, 2022

## Reminders

On **April 12th, 2022** all juniors will be taking the ACT test. This is free and required by the State of Wyoming. More information will be coming out in my March newsletter. There are a couple points I want to stress:

1. All junior students must be at school on April 12th.
2. All junior students need to be here before 8:00 a.m.
3. All junior students will test.
4. All junior students will take the 4 part multiple choice test and the writing portion of the test.
5. They do not need to worry about signing up for the test, the school takes care of that piece.
