Requirements

The Uinta County D.A.R.E. Officers' Scholarship is open to High School Seniors who will be graduating at the end of the current school year. The scholarships will be awarded to high school seniors from the Bridger Valley Schools who are graduates of a core curriculum D.A.R.E. class in Uinta County.

Requirements for consideration shall include the following:

1. D.A.R.E. graduate
2. Drug, Tobacco, Alcohol and Violence Free.
3. Maintained a 3.0 grade point average during their senior year of high school.
4. No criminal record
5. Letter of intent to include the following:
 - A. Grade Point Average
 - B. Academic Accomplishments
 - C. Long Term Goals
 - D. Essay on the impact of the D.A.R.E. program in their lives and the importance to stay drug, alcohol, tobacco and violence free.
 - E. Other scholarships applied for.
 - F. Years used as a D.A.R.E. role model.
 - G. School which you will be attending.
6. Applicant must be entering a College, University or Institute of higher learning the fall.
7. Three (3) letters of recommendation.
8. Scholarship recipient shall use the scholarship in the year that it is awarded.

Applications shall be submitted to the Mountain View High School Counselor by the second Friday in April. Each application must comply with the above requirement to be considered. The scholarship funds will be disbursed to the student, from Frostie Egley representing Uinta County D.A.R.E. Officers, prior to the first semester.
