# Reminders

On **April 11th, 2023** all juniors will be taking the ACT test. This is free and required by the State of Wyoming. More information will be coming out in my March newsletter. There are a couple points I want to stress:

1. Juniors do not need to sign up for the test, the school handles that.
2. All junior students must be at school on April 11th and test.
3. All junior students need to be here before 8:00 a.m.
4. All junior students will take the 4 part multiple choice test and the writing portion of the test.
