In celebration of the Hathaway Scholarship we will be having two dress up days during Hathaway Week 11/14-11/19. Please help us encourage our students to participate. Senior Parents:

Make sure you are talking with your students about any post-secondary institutions they are planning on applying to or have applied to. If you haven't done so already, be submitting the FAFSA. This is a big player in financial aid awards. Colleges are using this as a need-based calculator and using it for preliminary financial aid awarding. Look online for any scholarship opportunities as well as look at specific institutions for scholarships they might offer. Look ahead to the possibility of taking your student on campus visits. It is not too early for you and your student to be attending college visits and orientations. This is a great way for your student to get a feel for each particular school. Junior Parents:

Talk to your student about any career paths that may have come out of taking the ASVAB. They will have their test results as well as a career booklet to give them a starting place. We will have an interpretation of their results during English 11. This is a conversation starter to help them start thinking about their plan after high school. All colleges have net price calculators. Have your student look at colleges they interested in attending and see the approximate cost, this can be a real eye-opener. We have college visits during AHT. They are in our daily announcements.

Sophomore and Freshmen Parents:

Make sure you are reminding your students about how critical it is to pass all classes. Eight absences in a single class will result in a loss of credit, so the class will need to be repeated. They need to understand they need all classes for graduation. Continue to remind students how important their GPA is for scholarships and admission into college. It's harder to build up a GPA than to start strong and maintain it.

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Housekeeping

- ◆ **Seniors: December 1st**, is a priority deadline for many colleges, specifically for some scholarships. Seniors need to make sure they have applied, requested high school transcripts from Mrs. Hauf, and have received a provisional acceptance letter from colleges they are applying to. One in particular is the University of Wyoming and the **Trustees' Scholarship**. If you are unsure of your admittance status, please reach out to the University of Wyoming's Office of Admissions.
- ◆ **University of Wyoming Cowboy Commitment Scholarship Update:**
Students who apply any time from now until May 1 will be reviewed for Cowboy Commitment. New this year, students who take the ACT exam after they have been accepted will be reviewed to see if they could possibly move up to a higher level. Also, UW will review their final unweighted cumulative high school GPA to see if it increases for any possible upgrade. Please note this excludes Trustees' Scholars candidates because they must have their ACT score in by December 1.
- ◆ **Athletes:** remember to look into registration for NCAA or NAIA. If you have questions talk to Mrs. Hauf.
- ◆ **All Students:** look at or create a long-term plan of the classes you are going to take from MVHS. If you want to create a long-term plan with Mrs. Hauf come in and we will create one!
- ◆ **Schedule changes for Semester 2:** if your student needs a schedule change for semester two, please have them email me to set up an appointment starting in December.
- ◆ **Math tutoring available:** mornings in Mr. Petersen's room. Communicate with Mr. Petersen for more information.
- ◆ **University of Wyoming HSI**– see attached informational sheet.
- ◆ **Saturday School:** November 12th, 8-12 and November 19th, 8-12.
