Scholarship Qualifications:

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be eligible for the award:

- Sold an animal for at least three years at the Uinta County Junior Livestock sale.
- Application must have the signature of either the FFA advisor or 4-H Agent.
- Must have at least a 2.0 high school GPA - Must be a graduate in 2023 or prior.
- Must be a current 4-H or FFA member in good standing.
- Must be a full time student attending a secondary educational program (i.e. 2-year college, 4-year university, tech school)
- Must have held at least two leadership roles in any of the following areas:
 - FFA Chapter Officer
 - 4-H Club Officer
 - Junior Leader
 - Committee Chairperson
 - Student Council
 - Team Captain
 - Church Leadership
 - Other VSO position

Scholarship Selection: When completing application, members should include information from all years they were enrolled in either 4-H and/or FFA. Be as specific as possible. *Selection will be based on the following point breakdown*

1. Sale History - number of years the member sold an animal at the Uinta County Jr. Livestock Sale

- 8 or more 10 points
- 6-7 8 points
- 3-5 6 points

2. 4-H/FFA Activities- judging, skill-a-thons, chapter activities, community service, farm safety programs, fair concessions, Ag. days, Etc.

- 10 or more activities 10 points
- 9 activities 8 points
- 8 activities 6 points
- 7 activities 4 points
- 6 or less 2 points

3. Community Activities- any non 4-H/FFA activities

- 10 or more activities 5 points
- 9 activities 4 points
- 8 activities 3 points
- 7 activities 2 points
- 6 or less 1 point

4. Leadership roles held-

- 8 or more roles 10 points
- 7 roles 8 points
- 6 roles 6 points
- 5 roles 4 points
- 4 or less 2 points

5. Project scope- enrolled in different project or SAE areas (i.e. horticulture, swine, cake decorating, junior leaders, etc.)

- 5 or more projects 10 points
- 4 projects 8 points
- 3 projects 6 points
- 2 projects 4 points
- 1 project 2 points

6. Personal Summary- 10 points will be given for writing and expression skills of career goals and the impact of the 4H/FFA programs on member's life.

Official High School transcript must be submitted with application.

Application must have the required FFA Advisor or 4H Agent's signature on application or it will be disqualified.

Once all applications have been received, they will be scored by a non-bias committee.

Applicants can apply more than one year but may only be awarded the scholarship one time.

All Scholarships will be awarded during the fair.
