

Instructions for BOCES Scholarship Application

- ✓ Eligible applicants must be LHS or MVHS 2023 graduating Senior; or Valley Learning Center High School Equivalency graduate; or current WWCC outreach student residing in Bridger Valley; or current on-campus WWCC student originating from Bridger Valley.
- ✓ Deadline for application submission: Must be returned to **Valley Learning Center** **by 4:00 p.m. on April 18th, 2023.**
- ✓ Recipients must attend Western Wyoming Community College Fall 2023 semester to receive Scholarship first installment.
- ✓ High school grad winners will be notified by Valley Learning Center before high school graduation.
- ✓ High School Counselors and Principals will also be notified before graduation of scholarship recipients.
- ✓ Non-high school recipients will be notified before end of May.
- ✓ Scholarship award amounts may be based on, but not subject to, full time and part time WWCC student status, and awarded as determine by the BOCES board. Full time WWCC students are those taking 12 or more semester credits and part time WWCC students are those taking 6 - 11 semester credits.
- ✓ Western Wyoming Community College Financial Aid will disperse scholarship monies to student recipient through student accounts upon verification of student enrollment criteria.
- ✓ Awards will be divided and given in two semesters. Upon successful completion of the Fall semester and maintenance of a 2.0 GPA, the second half of the scholarship award will be given in Spring 2024.
- ✓ All applications will be considered on their own merits.
