Rules and Regulations Governing the Scholarship:

- 1. The recipient must have a high school diploma and be a graduate of Mountain View High School.
- 2. The recipient must pursue a course of study in an agriculture- or education-related degree program.
- 3. The applicant must submit the completed application, two letters of recommendation from someone outside of their family, and high school transcript.
- 4. Scholarship money must be used the school year following high school graduation.
- 5. The recipient may attend any college or university of their choice.
- 6. The scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$500. The student will receive \$250 when proof of registration for the first semester of college is submitted to the First Bank Mountain View Branch. The remaining \$250 will be received when proof of registration for the second semester of college is submitted to the First Bank Mountain View Branch.
- 7. The student must maintain a "B" average or 3.0 GPA to receive money for the second semester and must submit a copy of first semester grades to the First Bank Mountain View Branch.

The recipient will be chosen by the Bugas Family based on scholastic ability and the personal characteristics of dedication to school, community service, leadership skills and determination.
