Deadline to apply: April 1st.

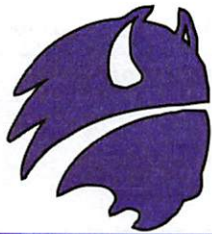
Western Wyoming Community College

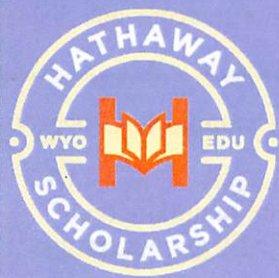
Most colleges require you to confirm your enrollment by **May 1st** in order to receive your scholarships. Make sure you know your deadlines and are checking your portals!
